Pennsylvania Capitol Tour and The National Civil War Museum Friday, September 27, 2024, 9:45 – 3:00

The **Pennsylvania State Capitol** was designed by architect Joseph Miller Huston in 1902 and completed in 1906 in a Beaux-Arts style with decorative Renaissance themes throughout. The Pennsylvania State Capitol is often referred to as a "palace of art" because of its many sculptures, murals and stained-glass windows, most of which are Pennsylvania themed or were made by Pennsylvanians. The building was listed on the National Register of Historic Places in 1977 and designated a National Historic Landmark in 2006.

**The National Civil War Museum**, in association with the Smithsonian Institution, is the largest museum in the United States that portrays the entire story of the American Civil War in equally balanced presentations that are humanistic in nature without bias to Union or Confederate causes.

Directions to the SHERATON HARRISBURG HERSHEY HOTEL, 4650 Lindle Rd, Harrisburg, PA 17111

The hotel is located just off exit 48 (Union Deposit) off I-83.

From the north: Route 81, Take exit 70 on the left to merge onto I-83 S, keep left at the fork to continue on I-283 S, follow signs for I-76/Pennsylvania Turnpike/Hbg Int'l Airport; Take exit 2 for PA-441 S; Turn left onto PA-441 S; Turn left onto High Pointe Blvd to the Sheraton on the left.

From the south: DE-1 N, follow signs for U.S. 1,U.S. Highway 1 N/Interstate 95/Wilmington/Baltimore; Take exit 165C on the left to merge onto I-95 N toward Wilmington/Philadelphia; Keep left at the fork to stay on I-95 N, follow signs for Interstate 95/Interstate 495/Wilmington/Philadelphia; take exit 8 to merge onto US-202 N; Take the US-202 N/US-322 W ramp to Paoli/Downingtown; Continue onto US-202 N/US-322 W/W Chester Bypass; Take the PA-100 N exit toward US-30 W/Exton; continue onto PA-100 N; Take the Pennsylvania Turnpike ramp; Keep left at the fork, follow signs for I-76 W/Harrisburg; Take exit 247 toward I-283 N; Continue onto I-283 N; Take exit 2 to merge onto PA-441 S; Turn left onto High Pointe Blvd to the Sheraton on the left.

From the east and west: Follow the Pennsylvania Turnpike to 283 north (exit 247); merge onto I-283 N toward Harrisburg/I-81/I-83, Take exit 2 to merge onto PA-441 S; Turn left onto High Pointe Blvd to the Sheraton on the left.
